

SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR “WHAT’S NEW IN RESOURCES.”

Pedagogical resources featured in *Réflexions* should reflect current trends in second language education and/or support teachers with needed cultural information and background materials to provide quality second language programming. They must reflect the priorities and needs of current CASLT members and the contexts in which they teach. Previously published resources that are still pertinent and would still be of interest to CASLT members may also be featured.

To be featured in *Réflexions*, educational publishers should submit one complimentary copy of a resource or product to the CASLT National Office. Each resource can be featured only once. For each issue, resources will be chosen by the Editor and Communications Officer to provide a balance of programming support (ESL, FSL, specific languages) and to include a variety of publisher representation.

CASLT members may also suggest resources to be featured. This will be advertised annually in *Réflexions*.
