



# Openings on CASLT's National Council – Saskatchewan Representative

We wish to inform you that the CASLT National Council (NC) representative position for Saskatchewan has become vacant, and that we are calling for nominations to fill this vacancy.

The NC consists of volunteer representatives from each province and territory who support CASLT's activities and initiatives in their respective regions. They attend provincial language association meetings in a liaison role, represent CASLT at language conferences or events, support communications and participation in CASLT's programs and activities underway in their region, and encourage membership recruitment and retention.

CASLT members in good standing in Saskatchewan who are interested in serving on the CASLT NC for a term of at least two years **must forward their candidacy by email to the national office at [casltadmin@caslt.org](mailto:casltadmin@caslt.org) by April 6, 2020**. NC representatives can serve up to three consecutive terms of two years.

The expression of interest must be received in writing and include the following:

- A **short bio** (75 words maximum) and a **digital photo** (high resolution passport format)
- A **message to CASLT members in your province** (100–250 words) explaining your motivation and qualifications to represent them.
- A resume (curriculum vitae)

*Persons who wish to present their candidacy to the NC or who want to vote must have an active membership with CASLT:*

- *before April 6, 2020, if you are a candidate*
- *before April 13, 2020, if you intend to cast a ballot.*

If no more than one expression of interest is received, the individual will be declared the provincial NC representative by acclamation.

In the event that interest is expressed by two or more members, an election will be conducted. On April 13, 2020, CASLT will notify all members in good standing within the province and send an online ballot of the candidates including a brief biography, photo, CV, and message to members of each candidate. The ballot must be completed online by April 24, 2020.

The new NC representative, whether elected or declared nominated by acclamation, will be notified and invited to attend CASLT's Annual General Meeting, as well as the NC meeting in Vancouver on October 23 and 24, 2020 at which time an official announcement will be made.
