Welcome to our latest issue of *Réflexions*! As President of CASLT, I look forward to working with our Board of Directors and staff as we advance our role in supporting second language education and serving the needs of our members throughout Canada.

CASLT had a very productive year in 2019, initiating many projects aimed at advancing our mission of excellence in teaching languages. I am delighted to update you on some of these ongoing projects and what we will be working on throughout 2020.

Research has always been a priority for CASLT so I am pleased to report that the *Literature Review on Computer-Assisted Language Learning* is in production. Many thanks to Dr. Mary Grantham O'Brien of the Language Research Centre at the University of Calgary for taking on this important work on our behalf. To be launched this spring, this valuable resource will provide further understanding of the pedagogy and tools used to teach and learn languages through new technologies.

Another project currently in progress is the "Languages Build..." advocacy campaign to promote the benefits of

learning a second or additional language. Based on CASLT's *Literature Review on the Impact of Second Language Learning*, this campaign runs until the end of June. Elements of the [Languages Build Advocacy Toolkit](#) are gradually being posted on CASLT's website. I invite you to join us in promoting the advantages of speaking multiple languages. I also invite you to participate in our [video contest](#), which asks Canadians to express their pride in learning one or both of Canada's official languages as a second or additional language.

On the professional development front, CASLT continues to offer in-person and online learning sessions addressing current and best practices in second language education. I am particularly impressed by the popularity of CASLT's online professional learning series of live one-hour sessions. CASLT is determined to make professional development more accessible to our members so we are currently developing an on-demand online learning centre.

I am also exceptionally pleased about our progress preparing the 2020 edition of *Celebrating Languages Without Borders*, organized






